* AHEAD2020 Announcement of Opportunity Cycle 3

The AHEAD2020 (Integrated Activities for High Energy Astrophysics*) calls for a program of transnational visits and remote access activities to be performed starting ~mid April 2022. The main objectives are:

- 1) fostering new or strengthening existing collaborations on science and technology topics in high energy astrophysics (visitor program);
- 2) provide access free of cost to selected European astronomical institutes and data centres for support in high energy and multimessenger data analysis, as well as computational astrophysics.
- 3) providing access free of cost to some of the best European ground test and calibration facilities relevant for high-energy astrophysics.

Visitor grants include full reimbursement of travel and subsistence expenses. To allow for possible restrictions to travel as an effect of the pandemic, the possibility of remote access for a number of services in the area of data analysis, tools and computational astrophysics will be provided.

** For activities concerning access to experimental facilities, submission will remain open and proposals can be submitted anytime until 28 June 2024; they will be evaluated typically within one month from delivery.

The <u>31st General Assembly of the IAU (IAUGA2022)</u> will be held from 2-11 August 2022 in Busan, South Korea in a hybrid format. The official webpage for registration and abstract submission is now open as of, 3 January 2022.

1. Registration

You have two options for registration: in-person and virtual. Virtual registrants can remotely attend all sessions, including the plenary talks, live-streaming oral sessions, and web-based galleries of e-talks and e-posters through the meeting platform. Please note that in-person registration is required for both on-site and remote oral contributions. The early-bird registration closes on 28 February 2022.

2. Abstract Submission

In-person registrants can submit up to 4 abstracts for oral/e-poster/e-talk presentations, while virtual registrants can submit up to 4 abstracts for e-poster/e-talk presentations. The regular abstract submission closes on 31 March 2022.

3. IAU grant

The IAU will offer an IAU grant to participants who may not have sufficient travel funds. Applicants must register for IAUGA2022 and fill out the <u>IAU grant application form</u> by 31 March 2022.

4. KAS grant

The Korean Astronomical Society (KAS) will offer a KAS Grant to participants who may not have travel grants, in the following three categories: students, early-career astronomers, and retired IAU members. For in-person recipients, some volunteer services will be requested by the IAUGA2022 National Organizing Committee. Applicants must register for IAUGA2022 and fill out the KAS grant application form by 28 February 2022.
